Annual Report – 22/23

In the beginning...

- Corporate Health Group no funds to take forward new employee initiative
- Morale issues in the wake of continuing austerity and organisational change
- Proposal to establish a private society lottery supported by Council
- NPT Staff Health and Well-being Group formed to take forward the initiative
- Independent of the Council and run by staff volunteers
- Lucky Fridays lottery initiative launched Sept 2015 with first prize draw Xmas 2015
- Company Ltd by guarantee formed in 2022/23 to protect the interests of the volunteer board members





Lucky Fridays

- Have to be a member of the NPT Health and Well-being Group
- Have to be on the Council payroll
- Lucky Fridays members pay £1 per week (£4.34 per calendar month) to be eligible for the Lucky Fridays lottery
- Limited to one entry per person
- Weekly prizes of £300; £200; £100 and £50
- Bonus prizes at the discretion of the Executive Committee
- Fabulous Fridays (1st Friday of the month) provides a bonus of £1,000; we aim to draw four £5,000 prizes per annum and also other bonus prizes depending on income
- Independent adjudicators for each weekly draw with different people pressing the button each week. Temporary arrangements put in place during pandemic.
- Audited by internal audit services; deductions made by payroll; communications by corporate comms team.
- Turnover currently circa £110,000 per annum
- Net increase of 303 new Lucky Fridays members this year smashing our target once again of 60 new members

Well-being

- Pandemic continued to disrupt our ability to deliver wellbeing programmes.
- Perkz subscriptions have been maintained.
- Cinema nights resumed Thor, Elvis, Mathilda, Top Gun
- Theatre offer discounted tickets on a variety of shows
- Increased expenditure on bonus prizes whilst wellbeing programme is re-introduced

Note: the purpose of the lottery is to improve the wellbeing of its members so we must maintain a wellbeing programme.

Annual General Meeting

Lucky Fridays

- Further targeted recruitment campaign to increase the number of members by at least a net gain of 5 per month;
- Retain weekly cash prizes of £300, £200, £100 and £50
- Retain Four mega bonus cash prizes of £5,000
- Fabulous Friday bonus increased to £1,500/month
- Additional bonus prizes during the year based on income generated (see table)
- Contribute 10% to the well-being account



Bonus Prize Schedule

- Fabulous Fridays = £1,500 (first Friday of every month)
- Easter = £500
- School's out mega draw = £5,000
- Coronation Bonus Draw 5X £500
- Payday bonus draw £1000 each month
- Lucky Friday's Birthday Bonanza Mega Draw = £5,000
- Halloween = £500
- Bonfire Night = £500
- Christmas Mega Draw = £5,000
- We Love Lucky Fridays Valentine's Day Bonus = £500
- St.David's Day Mega Draw = £5,000
- January in addition to the fabulous Friday draw, a bonus draw of £500 each week over the remainder of the month
- Additional bonus prizes at discretion of the Executive Committee

Well-being Programme

- Deliver a regular cinema night programme with a discount of £10 per showing for members
- Secure Early Bird or discounted prices for local events at Margam Park and the Council's theatres
- Secure discounted access to Celtic Leisure services
- Identify further opportunities for discounted prices at local events/services to alleviate cost of living pressures
- LUMINATE Wales discount
- Continue the Mental Well-being theme repeat the Men's mental health sessions and identify some new initiatives
- Identify further opportunities to relieve cost of living pressures on our members
- Continue the Perkz subscription
- Other initiatives at the discretion of the Executive Committee

Governance

- Ensure compliance with requirements applying to limited companies
- Arrange refresher training for new Executive Committee members on their role as Board members
- Maintain the Risk Register, Financial Policy and GDPR/Data Protection policy
